

# Important Notice

## Heavy Motor Salvage Buyers

---

**Pickles strives to comply with all relevant WHS and chain of responsibility legislation/requirements. The following will be strictly enforced onsite:**

- Heavy Motor Salvage assets **CANNOT** be started at any point for inspection, loading for collection and/or driven offsite.
- Heavy Motor Salvage purchases **MUST** be towed offsite unless the item is capable of being safely loaded with a forklift.
- A movement permit provided by a State registration/licencing authority will **NOT** be accepted by Pickles as an authorising document to allow for a Heavy Motor Salvage purchase to be driven offsite.
- Heavy Motor Salvage purchases requiring towing can only be collected by an authorised registered transport and/or tow company.
- Keys for Heavy Motor Salvage purchases will not be handed out to buyers at any time for inspection, or once purchased.
- Keys will only be handed to the authorised transport/tow company at the point of collection.
- Damaged semi-trailers **CANNOT** be collected with prime movers unless on registered tow plates and can only be collected by a licensed towing company.
- Heavy Motor Salvage assets delivered with the assistance of a crane must also be removed with the assistance of a crane and/or any other compliant means of transport.
- Pickles forklifts will **NOT** be used under any circumstance to assist in pushing Heavy Motor Salvage assets up loading ramps.
- Under **NO** circumstances will Pickles use two forklifts to lift a load so that a trailer can be driven under the load for loading/unloading.
- Buyers will be refused collection should the correct equipment **NOT** be supplied for collections.
- Buyers will be refused collection should the method of load restraint **NOT** be deemed safe or compliant.
- Buyers will be refused collection should the correct permits for over height/width loads **NOT** be supplied and sighted by a Pickles staff member.
- Under **NO** circumstance will any mechanical repairs, dismantling, or works be carried out on Heavy Motor Salvage purchases.
- All other WHS requirements apply. It is the responsibility of the buyer to acquaint themselves with any special requirements to comply with each States WHS legislation/regulations.
- If a Heavy Motor Salvage purchased item is loaded using a forklift Pickles will take all due care to load but will not be held responsible or liable for any damage.
- Pickles will not be held liable for any losses incurred by the buyer if loading is refused for any reason.
